Neighbor Running for County Council. Reggie Oldak is running as a Democratic candidate for the County Council in the seat vacated by Roger Berliner on account of term limits. The primary is June 26, 2018.

Montgomery Council Quiet Skies Coalition. Susan Lanham spoke about the massive increase in low-flying plane traffic over Tulip Hill due to FAA rerouting.
